I. Tree Leader Info: Neighborhood Street Tree Planting Applications should have a Leader and a Substitute Leader (in case of emergency) who will be the main contact person for PNPP, organize all participants for planting day, and ensure that participants care for their trees!

2. Planting Sites: Locate a planting route of at least five *separate* properties that each need at least one tree, within a 1 to 2 block area (the goal is for the plantings to take place in a concentrated area, and to create a tree-lined street) Requests for less than 5 properties are returned to be added to and submitted for a future planting cycle. Requests for more than 25 trees are considered on a case-by-case basis.

3. Resident/Participant Info: Leave a PNPP flier (page 4) at each address on your planting route. Each property owner should complete the tear off portion of the flier and return it to you as an agreement to abide by PNPP's planting agreement. (Tenants may sign up to be the one who will plant/water the trees, but the property owner or a representative must sign to verify approval to plant.) You must submit these forms to PNPP to complete your application!

4. Tree Route Info Sheet: On page 3 or on a separate attached sheet, list the information requested in the table, for each property/permission slip. (List in order of street address, making it as easy as possible to follow the route on foot or by car.)

5. Volunteers: Besides the resident/participants in the application, will any additional volunteers be helping you plant trees? _____ How many? _____

6. Utilities/Sidewalks: Are your sidewalks or gas lines scheduled to be replaced soon? _____
